A MOTION authorizing the transfer of the Enatai Beach Park to the City of Bellevue.

WHEREAS, King County now owns a park known as Enatai Beach, located wholly within the city limits of Bellevue, Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bellevue has agreed to maintain and use the subject property as a public park and recreation site, including improvements for a finger pier provided herein, for the citizens of the City of Bellevue and King County in exchange for the transfer of said property to the City of Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds that it is no longer appropriate and suitable for King County to own and manage this park property within the City of Bellevue; and

WHEREAS, the terms upon which the City of Bellevue is willing to receive said park property constitute adequate consideration for the transfer of such property to the City of Bellevue; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized and directed to execute a Quit Claim Deed transferring the Enatai Beach Park property to the City of Bellevue for and in consideration of ten dollars and other valuable considerations including the City of Bellevue's promise to maintain and operate the subject property as a public park and recreation facility for the use of all citizens of King County in perpetuity.
