

MOTION NO. 02981

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$73,447 to support Project Restart, Grant File No. 707:2.

WHEREAS, the Emergency Medical Service Act provides for the award of grants by the Department of Health, Education & Welfare, Public Health Service, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to continue the research into the impact of Emergency Medical Services in Suburban King County, and

WHEREAS, the results of such research are of potential value with regard to operation of Emergency Medical Services in King County and elsewhere.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$73,447 to the Department of Health, Education & Welfare, Public Health Service, on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

4. The Department of Health, Education & Welfare, Public Health Service, is/are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
