1 A MOTION proclaiming the week beginning
2 May 1, 1977 as Youth Week

3 WHEREAS, the Benevolent and protective Order of Elks has
4 designated the week beginning May 1st, as Youth Week to honor
5 America's Junior Citizens for their accomplishments, and to give
6 fitting recognition of their services to Community, State and
7 Nation; and

8 WHEREAS, Lake City Elks Lodge #1800 will sponsor an observance
9 during that week in tribute to the Junior Citizens of this
10 Community; and

11 WHEREAS, no event could be more deserving of our support and
12 participation than one dedicated to these young people who
13 represent the nation's greatest resource, and who in the years
14 ahead will assume the responsibility for the advancement of our
15 free society; and

16 WHEREAS, our Youth need the guidance, inspiration and
17 encouragement which we can give in order to develop these qualities
18 of character essential for future leadership; and

19 WHEREAS, to achieve this worthy objective we should demonstrate
20 our partnership with Youth, our understanding of their hopes and
21 aspirations and a sincere willingness to help prepare them in
22 every way for the responsibilities and opportunities of citizen-
23 ship;

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 The King County Council hereby proclaims the week beginning
26 May 1st as Youth Week and urges all departments of government,
27 civic, fraternal and patriotic groups, and citizens generally, to
28 participate wholeheartedly in its observance.
