2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
3 make application for Referendum 26 Solid
4 Waste grant funds from the Washington State
Department of Ecology, to support Skyhomish
Feasibility Study, Grant File No. 714:2.

5 WHEREAS, on November 7, 1972, the voters of the State of
6 Washington approved the sale of Referendum 26 Bonds for the use of
7 the Washington State Department of Ecology as matching grants for
8 the improvement and construction of solid waste facilities, and

9 WHEREAS, on July 28, 1976, the King County Council authorized
10 the sale of general obligation bonds for the purpose of acquisi-
11 tion, construction, installation, and improvement of solid waste
12 facilities, and the acquisition and purchase of solid waste equip-
13 ment, and

14 WHEREAS, on October 4, 1976, the King County Council approved
15 the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan which
16 set forth the need for capital improvements to the solid waste
17 system and presented a program for the orderly improvement of
18 solid waste facilities and equipment, and

19 WHEREAS, on October 12, 1976, the King County Comprehensive
20 Solid Waste Management Plan was submitted to the Department of
21 Ecology for their approval, and

22 WHEREAS, King County has met the requirements of the Depart-
23 ment of Ecology for the application of Referendum 26 grant funding
24 for solid waste facilities,

25 WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the
26 amount of \$9,620 as a cash match in support of the project.

27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

28 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make
29 application for Referendum 26 funds in the approximate amount of
30 \$9,620 to the Department of Ecology, on behalf of King County.

31 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file
32 and execute such applications and contracts as are required by the
33 grantor.
