2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
3 make application for funding assistance for
4 Highlands Park Outdoor Recreation as provided
5 by the Marine Recreation Land Act. Grant
6 File No. 711:2

7 WHEREAS, the Council of King County has approved a "Compre-
8 hensive Park and Recreation Plan" for the County which identifies
9 a community park in the northwestern part of King County as a
10 county priority, and

11 WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Marine Recreation Land
12 Act, state and federal funding assistance has been authorized and
13 made available to aid in financing the cost of land for parks and
14 the construction of outdoor recreational facilities of local public
15 bodies, and

16 WHEREAS, the Council of King County considers it in the best
17 public interest to acquire additional land adjoining the site of
18 Highlands Park and N. W. Innis Arden Way.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make
21 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$540,000 to the
22 Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation, on behalf of King
23 County;

24 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file
25 and execute such application and contracts as are required by the
26 grantor;

27 3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter
28 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
29 implementation of the project;

30 4. The Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation is
31 hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights
32 Act;

33 5. Any funding assistance so received be used in the acqui-
sition of forty-six (46) acres of land in the northwestern part of
the County of King, Washington;

1 6. Any property acquired with financial aid through the
2 Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation be placed in use as
3 an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in
4 perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the
5 County Council, the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation,
6 and any affected federal agency;

7 7. This resolution become part of a formal application to
8 the Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation.

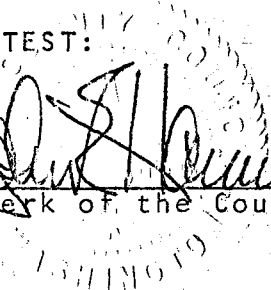
