MOTION NO. (3096)

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$15,000 to support the Mental Health Services for the Deaf Project, Grant File No. 721:2.

WHEREAS, the State Department of Social & Health Services is empowered to make grants to support mental health services, and

WHEREAS, the King County Mental Health Plan for 1977 identifies services to seriously disturbed persons as necessary in the public interest, and

WHEREAS, the Mental Health Services for the Deaf Project will assist the County in meeting the needs of deaf persons needing mental health services,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$15,000 to the State Department of Social & Health Services for the Mental Health Services to the Deaf Project on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

4. The State of Washington Department of Social and Health Services is hereby assured of full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
