WHEREAS, the Purchase Option executed between King County and the Milwaukee Road, as authorized by Motion No. 2435, passed by the King County Council on April 26, 1976, expressly provided for the sale of two parcels of property contiguous with said right of way to the Town of Carnation, and

WHEREAS, the said parcels, more fully described below, contain a total of 6.3 acres, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the fair market value of the parcels is \$2,500.00 per acre, yielding a total purchase price of Fifteen Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty and No/100 (\$15,750.00) Dollars, and
