MOTION NO. (3175)

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to exercise an option to purchase certain lands and improvements as an addition to the existing John McDonald Park.

WHEREAS, King County has executed an option to purchase 34 (thirty-four) acres of land together with improvements adjacent to the existing King County John McDonald Park, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County deems the purchase of said property and improvements to be in the best interest of the public and consistent with the King County park and recreation program, providing additional open space and a caretaker's residence, and

WHEREAS, the \$145,000 required for the purchase of said property is available,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the option and enter into a contract to acquire said property and improvements for public park and recreation purposes.

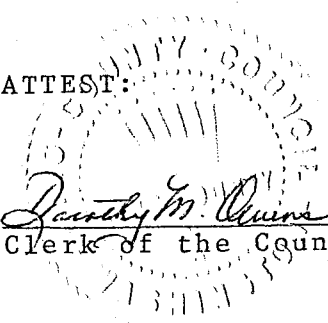
