2 A MOTION approving the Preliminary 1978 - 1983
3 Capital Improvement Program, as amended.

4 WHEREAS, the Council by Motion 1924 passed April 11, 1975, established
5 a schedule for the preparation of a preliminary Capital Improvement Program
6 for submittal to the Council by August 1 of each year to facilitate Council
7 review of the Capital Improvement Program, and

8 WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed the recommended Preliminary 1978-1983
9 Capital Improvement Program as submitted by the County Executive on August
10 9, 1977.

11 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

12 The recommended Preliminary 1978-1983 Capital Improvement Program has been
13 reviewed and amended to reflect the Council's intentions and priorities for the
14 1978-1983 Capital Improvement Program. The Council, by this motion, amends
15 the Preliminary 1978-1983 Capital Improvement Program as follows and requests
16 inclusion of these changes and concerns in the final 1978-1983 Capital Improve-
17 ment Budget and Program:

18 Council District 1

19 Intellectual and Leisure Time Opportunities - Parks

- 20 1. Hillwood Park Athletic Field Lighting - add a separate project
21 number and description to provide lights for the ballfields
22 (\$75,000 estimated) to be funded in 1978 with suggested funds
23 from the Shoreline Community Allocation (007065, p. ILT-157a).
- 24 2. Kellogg Junior High Tennis Courts - add as a separate project
25 number and description with needed funds (\$30,000) for construc-
26 tion of two courts suggested to come from the Shoreline Com-
27 munity Allocation (007065, p. ILT-157a).
- 28 3. Kenmore Logboom Park, Phase 2 (060051, p. ILT-79a) - accelerate
29 funding to 1978 to begin design and development of Phase 2.
- 30 4. North Central Shoreline (Shoreview High School Site Acquisition)
31 (070101, p. ILT-116) - update status of the State Interagency
32 Committee For Outdoor Recreation grant funding request for State
33 matching funds for acquisition in 1978.
- 34 5. Richmond Beach Addition (050181, p. ILT-141) - try to purchase
35 from the railroad owner.
- 36 6. Richmond Highlands Lighting for Ballfields - add as a separate
37 project number and description with the needed funds (\$75,000
38 estimated) suggested to come from the Shoreline Community
39 Allocation (007065, p. ILT-157a).

7. Shoreline #4 (Echo Lake) (080341, p. ILT-152) - move ahead with final site plan and development in 1978.
8. Shoreline Park #80 (McCormick Property) (080397, p. ILT-157) - complete development as soon as possible.

Transportation - Roads

1. Fremont Avenue North (100278, p. T(SR)-13c). Community does not want curbs or sidewalks; it would prefer gravel for the pedestrian walkway.
2. 40th Place N.E. (100572, p. T(SR)-50). The community would like to see 35th N.E. improved rather than 40th Place N.E., and road width is a concern.
3. North 200th (100175, p. T(SR)-75). Accelerate project to 1978.

Physical Environment - Flood Control

1. Swamp Creek (045224, p. PE(FC)-17a) - Accelerate funding for this project (\$45,000 estimated) to 1978.

Council District 3

Council District 5

Intellectual and Leisure Time Opportunities - Parks

1. Seattle Tennis Center (Project 007252, p. ILT-140a) - Provide \$400,000 from Revenue Sharing for this project in 1978.

Council District 6

Intellectual and Leisure Time Opportunities - Parks

1. Coalfield Park (Issaquah #1) (081101, p. 17a) - design and start development in 1977 for completion in 1978; this area badly needs it.
2. Cougar Mountain Park (040072, p. ILT-19) - design and develop in 1978 sufficiently to include a caretaker to deal with vandalism problems.

Roads

1. 68th South (New Project) - add to 6-Year Plan and to the proposed budget for C.I.P. 1978.
2. East Lake Sammamish Way (New Project) - Public Works should make a proposal for a study for pedestrian and bicycle path.
3. Coal Creek Parkway (400374, p. T(SR)-8) - provide scope and schedule information.

Council District 7

Transportation - Roads

1. S.W. 127th Street (600578, p. T(SR)-60a) - the community would not like to see the road widened and paved.

- 2. Des Moines Way South (607371, p. T(SR)-9) - The community needs the improvement to this major access to the freeway. The project must be funded in 1978.
- 3. 4th S.W. Connector (601172, p. T(SR)-45) - Accelerate the condemnation procedures and begin the construction.
- 4. South 146th Street (600373, p. T(SR)-68) - Accelerate the project.

Intellectual and Leisure Time Opportunities

Council Districts 7 & 8

Physical Environment - Flood Control

- 1. Salmon Creek Sewer Trunk (New Project) - To alleviate Salmon Creek pollution, flood damage and Salmon Creek Canyon erosion the Salmon Creek Sewer Trunk needs to be cleaned out. Between \$50,000 and \$75,000 should be presented to the Council to cover the costs. This is project to be completed by March 30, 1978.

District 8

Intellectual and Leisure Time Opportunities - Parks

- 1. Lakewood Park (070211, p. ILT-95) - although development of swimming facilities was completed in 1973, Lake Garrett is closed to swimming because of pollution. This area needs this aquatic facility. Accelerate effort and time factors in finding the cause of the pollution and recommending a solution for Council action as soon as possible.
- 2. Skyway Park (070241, p. ILT-159) - this area needs the attention of further development. Further information will be communicated to the Executive upon receipt of community preferences.
- 3. White Center (070271, p. ILT-179)- this area needs a community activity center. Accelerate the design and improvement into 1978 of the fieldhouse to serve as an activity center; also provide for the stadium bleachers.

Council District 9

Intellectual and Leisure Time Opportunities - Parks

- 1. Enumclaw Park (007021, p. ILT-33) - Get field lighting in as soon as possible for the 1977 football season. Rest rooms need construction as soon as possible in 1978.
- 2. Lea Hill/Green River Community College Park (070131, p. ILT-98a) complete acquisition as soon as possible and insure that design is completed in 1978 and development started as soon thereafter as possible.
- 3. Tahoma #1 (Maple Valley Heights) (081701, p. ILT-170) - complete construction in 1978.

4. Tahoma #2 (081711, p. ILT-171) - complete design and begin development.

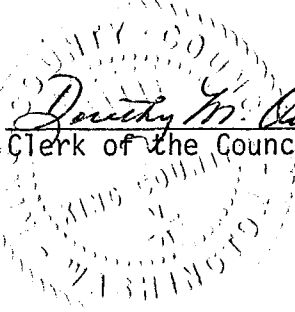
