A MOTION authorizing the Executive to cooperate and participate in the preparation of Joint applications for Community Development Block Grant projects.

WHEREAS, King County has an interest in pursuing cooperative ventures with the cities and towns in King County to the end that the citizens of King County will have the use of coordinated and effective services and facilities.
