MOTION NO. 03186

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$1,170,769 to support the Cedar Hills Leachate Interceptor Project, Step 3, Grant File No. 746:2

WHEREAS, the State Water Pollution Control Laws (RCW 90.48) as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Department of Ecology, and

WHEREAS, the Federal Water Pollution Control Act P.L. 92-500, as amended, provides for the award of grants by the Environmental Protection Agency, and

WHEREAS, the Cedar Hills Landfill Leachate Interceptor project Step 3 will assist the County in meeting the need to improve water quality in Mason and Issaquah Creeks, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$26,017 as an in-kind contribution and \$104,068 as a cash match in support of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$975,641 to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and in the approximate amount of \$195,128 to the State Department of Ecology for the Cedar Hills Leachate Interceptor project on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

1 4. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the Department of Ecology
2 are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.

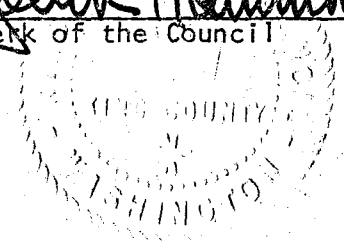
