4 1. Proviso Two of Motion No. 3097 is hereby waived and the
5 County Executive is authorized to enter into an interlocal agree-
6 ment for the purpose of jointly developing a work program to
7 guide the formulation of an interim policy and regulatory plan
8 for the purposes of planning and regulating development to mitigate
9 existing and future flooding in the Lower Green River Valley until
10 such time as federal flooding protection projects are implemented.

11 2. The Planning Division, Department of Planning and
12 Community Development is assigned full responsibility to carry
13 out or coordinate all County planning activities associated with
14 the Green River Valley SCS Watershed and Corps of Engineers Flood
15 Control Projects.

2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive
3 to carry out the County's responsibilities
4 for developing a work program to guide the
formulation of an interim policy and regu-
latory plan for the Green River Watershed.

5 WHEREAS, by Motion No. 2282, the County Council requested
6 the County Executive to carry out certain studies to determine
7 the most effective means to implement the Green River SCS
8 Watershed and Corps of Engineers Flood Control Projects and to
9 complete said studies by December 31, 1976; and

10 WHEREAS, by Motion No. 2312, the County Executive was
11 authorized to request \$75,000 in Community Development Block
12 Grant funds to carry out these studies and this request was
13 approved by the Joint Policy Committee; and

14 WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 2646, the County Council appro-
15 priated the \$75,000 of Community Development Block Grant funds
16 to the River Improvement Fund; and

17 WHEREAS, by Motion No. 2617, the Council authorized exten-
18 sion of the completion date of the studies to July 1, 1977; and

19 WHEREAS, by Motion No. 3097, the King County Executive was
20 authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with the Green
21 River Valley cities for the purpose of jointly developing a work
22 program to guide the formulation of an interim policy and regu-
23 latory plan to govern new development and to mitigate the adverse
24 impacts of existing and future flooding in the Lower Green River
25 Watershed which are likely to occur before federal flood control
26 projects are implemented; and

27 WHEREAS, Motion No. 3097 specified the work program be
28 consistent with the development of the King County Subregional
29 Land Use Plan and the work program of the Office of Agriculture,
30 as specified in Ordinance 3064; and

31 WHEREAS, before entering into the Interlocal Agreement, the
32 County Executive was requested by Motion No. 3097 to prepare and
33 present to the Council a staffing plan with necessary budget
