A MOTION proclaiming Farm-City Week
November 19 through November 25, 1977.

WHEREAS, the prosperity and well-being of this community
are dependent upon cooperation between the two great elements of
our society: farmers and urban people, and

WHEREAS, the complexities of their individual problems and
the divergence of their activities have led to a widening gulf
of misunderstanding, and

WHEREAS, this gulf of misunderstanding must be eliminated,
and each group must understand the other if our American way of
life is to endure, and

WHEREAS, Farm-City Week provides an unparalleled opportunity
for farm and city people to become re-acquainted,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The period of November 19 through November 25 is hereby
proclaimed to be Farm-City Week.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED,

The Office of Agriculture and all citizens of this community
are called upon to participate to the limit of their capability
in the joint visits, the seminars the pageants, fairs, civic, and
social events attendant to a successful Farm-City Week in
King County.
