MOTION NO. C3332

A MOTION declaring the intention to form a Road Improvement District for underground wiring in the Lake Forest Park area and to set a date and place for a public hearing.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the King County Council requesting the formation of a Road Improvement District for the conversion of existing overhead wiring to underground wiring and the erection of ornamental street lights in the streets in the Lake Forest Park area. The petition requests that the payment for the improvement be made by special assessment payable in fifteen (15) equal annual installments, and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the King County Council on September 29, 1977, referred the above said petition to the Director, Department of Public Works and Transportation for his checking and recommendation, and

WHEREAS, said Director has contacted Seattle City Light and Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone Company and they have established a boundary that is feasible for the improvement district, and

WHEREAS, the Director, Department of Public Works and Transportation, has certified that said petition has been signed by owners of 73 percent of the lineal front footage upon the proposed improvement, and 74 percent of the area and 74 percent of the assessable building lots within the boundary of the proposed improvement district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.020, 36.88.050, and 36.88.410, it is the intention of the County Council of King County, Washington, to order the improvement of the streets in the plat of Forest Heights (65/100) and Tax Lots 35, 57, 81, and 92 lying within the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 3, Township 26 N., Range 4 East, W.M. Said improvement shall consist of the conversion of existing overhead electric and communication facilities to underground facilities and the conversion of

1 at 9:30 a.m., on the 30th day of January, 1978,  
2 which time and place are hereby fixed for hearing on an Ordinance  
3 relating to said proposed improvements and all objections thereto,  
4 and for confirming the method of payment as petitioned for this  
5 improvement.

6 5. The Director, Department of Public Works and Transporta-  
7 tion, is hereby directed to submit to the King County Council at  
8 or prior to the date fixed for such hearing, a diagram or print  
9 showing thereon the lots and other property which will be  
10 specially benefited thereby and the estimated amount of cost and  
11 expense of such improvement to be borne by each buildable site.

12 6. The Clerk of the King County Council is hereby directed  
13 to give notice of said hearing by publication in at least two  
14 consecutive issues of a newspaper of general circulation in such  
15 county with the date of the first publication to be at least  
16 fifteen days prior to the date of said hearing, and a notice of  
17 such hearing is to be mailed by the Department of Public Works and  
18 Transportation setting forth the nature of the proposed improvement,  
19 the total estimated cost, the estimated amount of the cost and  
20 expense of such improvement to be borne by the particular lot, the  
21 date and place of the hearing before the County Council, and the  
22 fact that property owners may withdraw their names from the  
23 petition or add their names thereto at any time prior to 4:30 p.m.  
24 of the day before the hearing, to each owner or reputed owner of  
25 any lot or other property within the proposed improvement district  
26 at the address as shown on the tax rolls of the Office of the  
27 Comptroller.
