AN ORDINANCE relating to public safety; transferring jurisdiction of civil and criminal cases from the Municipal Court of the City of Medina to the King County Justice Court, Bellevue District.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MEDINA, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All cases, proceedings and matters pending before the municipal Court of Medina, as of January 31, 1978 shall be and hereby are transferred to the King County Justice Court, Bellevue District, together with all files, records and proceedings relating to such cases. Such transfer shall not affect any appeal from the Municipal Court of the City of Medina, but such appeal may be conducted and concluded as though this ordinance had not ^{been} ~~bee~~ enacted, except that, if remanded from the Superior Court, the superseding court shall have the authority and power to forfeit bail or bond or impose sentence thereon.

Section 2. The enactment of this ordinance shall not have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall be in existence at the date that this ordinance becomes effective; nor shall the transfer of cases, proceedings, and matters under the provisions hereof have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying any liability, civil or criminal, which shall be in existence at the date of such transfer.

Section 3. Any act or acts authorized by this ordinance and performed prior to the effective date hereof, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. Upon passage of this ordinance the City Clerk is hereby directed to deliver a Certified Copy of the same to the county council for King County, Washington for approval.

Section 5. The effective date of this ordinance shall be January 31, 1978.




