MOTION NO. 03383

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make grant applications for funds in the approximate amount of \$2,582,000 to support four Multipurpose Trails Projects, Grant File No. 807:2.

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, is empowered to make grants to support recreation and conservation use of abandoned railroad rights-of-way, and

WHEREAS, the applications will assist the County in meeting the needs expressed in the 1971 Urban Trails Plan and the 1975 Bicycle Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$287,900 as a cash match in support of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make applications for funds in the approximate amount of \$2,582,000 in support of four Multipurpose Trails projects: Snoqualmie-Tanner, Lake Wilderness CIP 007244, Snoqualmie Valley CIP 007242, Preston-Snoqualmie CIP 007243, as described in Grant file 807:2 to the Department of the Interior, Bureau of Outdoor Recreation, on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

4. The Department of the Interior is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
