MOTION NO. 03-103

A MOTION denying the petition by Dennis R. Thompson and others for the vacation of a portion of Lake Kathleen Road S.E., concurring with the recommendation of the Department of Public Works and returning the petitioner's \$100 deposit (V-1545)

WHEREAS, Dennis R. Thompson and others have submitted a petition for the vacation of a portion of Lake Kathleen Road S.E.; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works investigated the proposed vacation petition and the vacation area and recommends that the petition be denied and that petitioner's \$100 deposit be returned to him; and

WHEREAS, the vacation area is a small bubble cul-de-sac and approval of the vacation would leave platted lots without legal access to the County road. The County Operations Division has agreed to extend an existing drainage ditch and eliminate the nuisance condition that caused the petitioners to file the petition;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council concurs with the recommendations of the Department of Public Works and Real Property Division and hereby denies the petition by Dennis R. Thompson and others for the vacation of a portion of Lake Kathleen Road S.E. (V-1545), described as follows:

Gravel cul-de-sac abutting the east side of Lake Kathleen Road S.E. and abutting Lots 41, 42, 43, and 44 of Kathlena Estates, according to Plat recorded in Volume 67 of Plats, pages 93 and 94, Records of King County, Washington. Situate in Section 18, Township 23 N., Range 6 East, W.M. Contains approximately 4,250 sq.ft., more or less.

BE IT FURTHER MOVED the \$100 deposit is to be returned to the petitioner.
