2 A MOTION relating to the Des Moines/King
3 County Fishing Pier and Artificial Reef and
4 authorizing the Executive to make joint
5 application with the City of Des Moines for a
6 grant from the Interagency Committee for
7 Outdoor Recreation.

8 WHEREAS, the State Interagency Committee for Outdoor
9 Recreation (IAC) will meet on March 31, 1978, to consider
10 applications from local governments, and

11 WHEREAS, IAC Project #I-78-0270, Des Moines/King County
12 Fishing Pier and Artificial Reef, will be among those considered,
13 and

14 WHEREAS, the King County Council endorsed the project by
15 agreeing to act as co-sponsor with the City of Des Moines in a
16 successful application for Joint Projects Funds from the 1977
17 Housing and Community Development Block Grant, and

18 WHEREAS, the Required match for an IAC grant has been
19 secured from the following Block Grant Funds:

2 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

3 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized on behalf
4 of King County to make joint application for funds with the City
5 of Des Moines in the amount of \$215,500 to the Interagency
6 Committee for Outdoor Recreation.

7 2. The County Executive is hereby authorized to file and
8 execute such application and contracts as are required by the
9 grantor.

10 3. The County Executive is also authorized to enter into
11 and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
12 implementation of the project.

13 4. The Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation is
14 hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights
15 Act.
