MOTION NO. 03496 78-397

A MOTION requesting review by the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner of the reclassification petitioned by THOMAS H. KLEIN, JR., ET AL, designated File No. 105-78-R, and approved by the King County Council by Motion NO. 3431.

WHEREAS, on March 27, 1978 the King County Council adopted Motion No. 3431 concurring with the recommendation of the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner on the application for reclassification petitioned by THOMAS H. KLEIN, JR. ET AL, designated File No. 105-78-R. and

WHEREAS, it has been represented that the petition for reclassification was signed by Henry Jacques representing property co-owned by himself and his brothers Frank Jacques, Ovide Jacques and Wilton Jacques without their knowledge or consent, and

WHEREAS, the petitioners reason for seeking the reclassification from RS 7200 to Suburban-Residential was to permit the keeping of horses on their property, but not to prohibit the keeping of other livestock on the subject property, and

WHEREAS, the application for reclassification from RS 7200 to Suburban-Residential was approved subject to the "P" Suffix with the condition that only horses be permitted on the subject property,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT MOVED BY the Council of King County:

1. The Zoning and Subdivision Examiner is hereby requested to review and re-hear the THOMAS H. KLEIN JR., ET AL reclassification designated File No. 105-78-R with specific reference to conditions restricting the type of livestock on the subject property to horses.
