MOTION NO. 03502

A MOTION establishing a Federal Way Community Plan Revision Committee and establishing the responsibilities of the Community Plan Revision Committee and the King County Planning Division in developing amendments to the Federal Way Communities Plan and approving the appointment of citizens to serve on the Federal Way Community Plan Revision Committee.

WHEREAS, a Community Plan for Federal Way was adopted June 9, 1975 by Ordinance No. 2401, and

WHEREAS, Motion 2844 was passed on January 17, 1977 "providing for the redesignation of certain areas on the Federal Way Community Plan map from low density residential to medium density residential when sanitary sewer service is provided", and

WHEREAS, the Lakehaven Sewer District Comprehensive Sewer Plan 1977 was adopted November 9, 1977 by Ordinance No. 3484 subject to the condition that appropriate legislation be prepared "to clarify and resolve inconsistencies between area zoning, Motion No. 2844, the Lakehaven Sewer District Comprehensive Sewer Plan and the Federal Way Community Plan in order to ensure that the design and phasing of sewer service for areas encompassed by Motion No. 2844 is consistent with the Community Plan", and

WHEREAS, preliminary study has been initiated by the Planning Division on revision of the Federal Way Communities Plan, and

WHEREAS, the King County Executive and the King County Council (Councilpersons from Districts No. 7 and No. 9), have recommended twenty members and four alternates to serve on a Federal Way Communities Plan Revision Committee in response to Ordinance No. 3484,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
There is hereby established a twenty-one member Federal

1 Way Communities Plan Revision Committee to be appointed as
2 follows:

- 3 1. Fourteen (14) members and two (2) alternates to be ap-
4 pointed by the Councilpersons from Districts No. 7 and No. 9;
- 5 2. Six (6) members and two (2) alternates to be appointed
6 by the County Executive;
- 7 3. A Chairperson appointed by the Chairperson of the
8 Policy Development Commission;
- 9 4. Alternates are to serve in the event a member is unable
10 to complete his or her term, and additional alternates, if needed,
11 are to be appointed by the original appointer of the member
12 leaving the Committee, and approved by the Council;
- 13 5. Alternates shall assume committee membership based on
14 the closest geographic proximity to the member resigning;
- 15 6. All Committee members and alternates shall be subject
16 to the disclosure provisions of K.C.C. 3.04.050.

17 BE IT FURTHER MOVED by the Council of King County:

18 The Federal Way Communities Plan Revision Committee shall:

- 19 1. Assist the Planning Division in developing policies
20 and map alternatives for the Federal Way Study Area (see attached
21 map) in response to Ordinance No. 3484;
- 22 2. Recommend a revised Community Plan to the Council and
23 Executive along with any alternatives the Committee or the
24 Planning Division may wish to include.

25 BE IT FURTHER MOVED by the Council of King County:

26 The Planning Division shall:

- 27 1. Prepare a community profile to include an inventory and
28 analysis of the environment, development characteristics and
29 public facilities, concentrating on the study area, and including
30 existing plans and policies applicable to the area;
- 31 2. Prepare for review proposed policies and map alterna-
32 tives;

1 3. Advise the Committee of possible impacts of proposed
2 policies and map alternatives;

3 4. Prepare preliminary and final Community Plan documents
4 and Environmental Impact Statements.

5 BE IT FURTHER MOVED by the Council of King County:

6 1. The scope of the Federal Way Community Plan revision
7 shall be concerned primarily with land use distribution and
8 densities and sewer service areas.

9 2. Said attached list of members of the Federal Way
10 Communities Plan Revision Committee is approved as presented.

11 3. The schedule for completion of the Federal Way Commu-
12 nities Plan will be as follows:

13 a) May 11, 1978: Community Profiles completed and
14 presented to the community;

15 b) August 7, 1978: Final Proposed Plan Revision
16 completed and referred to the County Council for adoption.

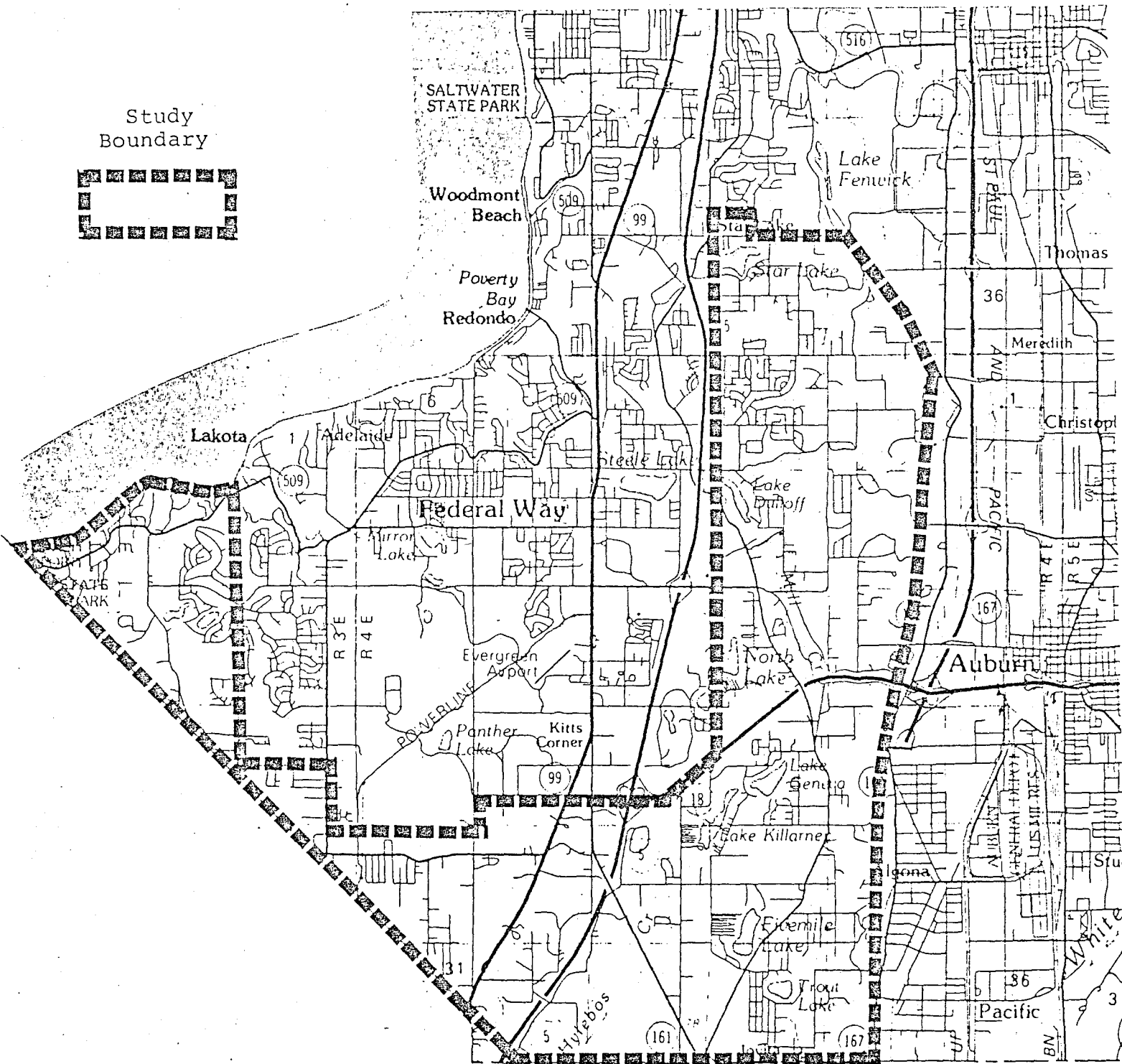
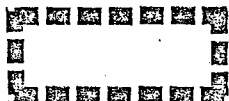
