2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to  
3 make a grant application in the approximate  
4 amount of \$1,142,590 to support the Seattle-  
King County drug abuse treatment system.

5 WHEREAS, the Department of Health, Education and Welfare  
6 through its National Institute on Drug Abuse is empowered to make  
7 grants to support treatment services for drug abusers, and

8 WHEREAS, the residents of King County have benefited from  
9 such grants over the past six years, and

10 WHEREAS, the Center for Addiction Services and its affiliate  
11 agencies will continue to assist the county in meeting the needs  
12 of drug abusers through a program of detoxification, methadone  
13 maintenance, residential treatment, counseling, and screening and  
14 referral, and

15 WHEREAS, certain fiscal and management deficiencies have  
16 been noted in the drug treatment system, deficiencies which could  
17 have a negative impact on the delivery of services if not  
18 corrected;

19 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

20 1. The County Executive is hereby authorized to make  
21 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$1,142,590 to  
22 the National Institute of Drug Abuse on behalf of King County,

23 PROVIDED THAT:

24 a. All contracts and subcontracts executed under this grant  
25 authorization shall provide for disclosure to the county of all  
26 revenues, from whatever source, received by the contracting  
27 agency and of all expenditures, of whatever nature, made by the  
28 agency. Such disclosure shall include actual, as well as  
29 budgeted, revenues and expenditures.

30 b. Executive staff shall provide assistance to Council  
31 staff in conducting a study of the actual unit cost of each drug  
32 abuse treatment service. Such a study is hereby authorized and  
33 the Council Administrator is directed to present its results no

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1 later than August 18, 1978.

2 c. No later than December 1, 1978, the Executive shall  
3 present to the Council a report of the first four months of  
4 operation under this grant which includes the following elements:

5 (1) The number of contracted slots and the monthly  
6 utilization rate of those slots;

7 (2) The budgeted amount of reimbursement for services and  
8 the actual amount paid monthly to each contractor and  
9 subcontractor;

10 (3) A narrative discussion, supported by objective  
11 financial and program analysis, of the adequacy of the  
12 reimbursement rate as it applies to individual contractors and  
13 subcontractors;

14 (4) A projection for each individual contractor of the  
15 balance or deficit which would result from continuing the  
16 reimbursement rate authorized herein in the second six months of  
17 the fiscal year;

18 (5) A recommendation from the Executive on changes in the  
19 reimbursement rate for the second six months of the fiscal year.

20 2. Federal moneys received under this grant authorization  
21 shall be allocated as follows:

27 These monetary and slot allocations shall not be changed  
28 without prior approval of the County Council.

29 3. The Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute  
30 such application and contracts as are required by the grantor.

31 4. The Executive is also authorized to enter into and  
32 execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation  
33 of the project.

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1 5. The Department of Health, Education and Welfare is  
2 hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights  
3 Act.

4 6. The Council intends to incorporate elements of this  
5 grant authorization as well as recommendations of its Audit  
6 Committee in a subsequent ordinance.
