A MOTION proclaiming June 24 - July 2,
1978 as KING COUNTY STRAWBERRY WEEK.

WHEREAS, King County strawberries are known far and wide
for their superior quality and exceptional flavor,

WHEREAS, the local harvest, eagerly awaited, is now at the
peak and will be completed in a week or two,

WHEREAS, Washington State is the third largest producer of
strawberries in the nation and the King County crop ranks in
the top five in the State,

WHEREAS, the County crop adds over half a million dollars
annually to the local agricultural economy and provides summer
employment for thousands of school-aged children.

WHEREAS, local strawberries will be available at many
restaurants and produce markets during the coming weeks.

WHEREAS, many local strawberry fields are open to the public

the brief and glorious season of this important crop,
