WHEREAS, the people of King County, through their elected officials and by action of the State Legislature have ratified the Equal Rights Amendment, but are being denied its benefits because of the failure of three additional States to ratify it; and

WHEREAS, King County officials and staff attend conventions at County expense to the National Association of County Officials and other organizations concerned with local government;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

That King County officials and staff shall work within those organizations of which they are members to hold conventions or meetings only in States which have ratified the Equal Rights Amendment.
