MOTION NO. 3628

A MOTION revising block grant project CD-489-77 to allow the City of Tukwila to use \$64,118 in County population funds for acquisition and/or renovation of the Southgate School rather than the Thorndyke School for use as a Senior Center.

WHEREAS, the County Council has allocated \$64,118 in County "population" block grant funds to the City of Tukwila, and

WHEREAS, these funds were intended to be used to renovate the Thorndyke School for use as a Senior Center serving the City of Tukwila and surrounding King County, and

WHEREAS, the City of Tukwila has decided that such a Senior Center would be more appropriately located in or near the City limits of Tukwila, and

WHEREAS, the City of Tukwila has identified the Southgate School at 4101 S. 131st as a better location for a Senior Center,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The \$64,118 allocated to block grant project CD-489-77 is to be used to assist the City of Tukwila in acquiring and/or renovating the Southgate School for use as a Senior Center serving the residents of the City of Tukwila and surrounding unincorporated area.
2. By making this contribution to the acquisition of a senior center facility, the County makes no commitment to support future operating or program costs.
