MOTION NO. 03633

A MOTION approving the feasibility study titled "Solid Waste Disposal Alternatives for the Skykomish Area" and authorizing the County Executive to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the Town of Skykomish.

WHEREAS, the King County Council by its Ordinance No. 2918 adopted the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan on October 4, 1976, and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Plan recommends the closure of the Skykomish dump and its replacement with the most practical and economical program, and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Division of King County in conjunction with the Town of Skykomish has completed the feasibility study "Solid Waste Disposal Alternatives for the Skykomish Area," and

WHEREAS, the feasibility study recommends the construction of a transfer station to be built and maintained by King County, to serve the Skykomish area, and

WHEREAS, the feasibility study was presented to the King Sub-Regional Council, Solid Waste Management Committee on May 17, 1978, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Skykomish by its Resolution No. 92, dated June 19, 1978, adopted the feasibility study and its recommendation and authorized an Interlocal Agreement with King County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Council approves the feasibility study "Solid Waste Disposal Alternatives for the Skykomish Area" and its recommendation for the construction of a transfer station to serve County residents and Town residents in the Skykomish area.
