2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a
3 grant application for funds in the approximate amount
4 of \$249,460 to support improved pre-trial release
5 programs for jail detainees and improved monitoring
6 capabilities of the Subject-in-Process management
7 information system.

8 WHEREAS, the Department of Justice, LEAA is providing funds to local
9 governments to support projects which establish or improve pre-trial release
10 programs that would relieve jail over-crowding, and

11 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to support pre-trial
12 release programs that propose to reduce the jail over-crowding situation, and

13 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to support improvements
14 to the Subject-in-Process information system that will assist in the improve-
15 ment of jail management and the delivery of pre-trial services, and

16 WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that provision of such services
17 is in the public interest, and

18 WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of
19 \$27,718 as a cash match in support of the projects.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

21 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application
22 for funds in the approximate amount of \$249,460 to the Department of Justice,
23 LEAA for the Coordinated Intake Program on behalf of King County.

24 2. No funds shall be appropriated to support these functions until the
25 Executive recommends whether King County will pay the local cash match


3 3. The Department of Justice, LEAA is hereby assured full compliance
