MOTION NO. 3720

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to execute an interlocal agreement regarding the annexation and development of the South Fork Interchange area.

WHEREAS, the City of North Bend has adopted a resolution approving a petition for the annexation of 460 acres of land located south of the City and adjacent to the I-90 Interstate Highway bypass and South Fork Interchange, to be effective August 15, 1978, and

WHEREAS, the City of North Bend has approved a Final Environmental Impact Statement concerning the proposed annexation and development of a 60 acre portion of the total 460 acres, the development to consist of highway-oriented services and facilities, multiple family units, and single family residential structures, and

WHEREAS, the City of North Bend and R & R Properties have worked cooperatively with King County to address the concerns raised by the County in its May 18, 1978, letter regarding the proposed annexation and development, and regarding the draft Environmental Impact Statement, and

WHEREAS, an interlocal agreement has been prepared which establishes the following:

- 1) a site plan and protective covenants which assure an environmentally sensitive development, adequate open space areas, and the prohibition of specified non-highway oriented uses for the 60 acre portion;
- 2) contract zoning retaining current King County "G" zoning for a period of five years for the remaining 400 acres;
- 3) notification to King County of any proposed zoning change on land within the proposed annexation abutting King County boundaries.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to execute the interlocal agreement in substantially the form as attached.
