MOTION NO. 3919

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$50,000 to support King County's Facility Energy Reduction Project, Grant File No. 902:2.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Energy, Region X is empowered to make grants to support Appropriate Technology Small Grants Program, and

WHEREAS, the King County Facility Energy Reduction Program will assist the County in meeting the needs of more efficient energy utilization in the Park Division's operations, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to support energy conservation as set forth in the County's Energy Conservation and Policies adopted April 3, 1978 in Ordinance #3649, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that provisions of such services is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$50,000 to the United States Department of Energy, Region X for the Facility Energy Reduction Project on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
