2 A MOTION adopting the 1979 Drug Abuse Plan,  
3 and authorizing the Executive to transmit it  
4 to the State of Washington.

5 WHEREAS, state grant-in-aid funds are provided to King  
6 County to support a program of rehabilitation for those persons  
7 suffering from problems related to drugs, and

8 WHEREAS, county receipt of state funds is contingent upon  
9 review and approval by the Department of Social and Health  
10 Services of an annual plan for services, and

11 WHEREAS, the Drug Commission has recommended to the County  
12 Council the 1979 Drug Abuse Plan which contains policies for the  
13 expenditures of state grant-in-aid funds, and

14 WHEREAS, the 1979 Plan differs substantially from the 1978  
15 Plan in that the 1978 Plan also contained policies for the  
16 expenditure of federal funds granted by the National Institute on  
17 Drug Abuse (NIDA), and

18 WHEREAS, during 1978, NIDA has refused to honor the policy  
19 decisions contained in the 1978 Plan and subsequent Council  
20 motions, especially Motion 3722, and has withdrawn its grant from  
21 the county, and

22 WHEREAS, NIDA now is contracting directly with treatment  
23 agencies and has used moneys formerly allocated to King County  
24 for administration to increase revenues to the agencies, and

25 WHEREAS, the County Council still believes that the policies  
26 adopted in Motion 3722 provide the proper framework for  
27 administering the drug treatment system, and

28 WHEREAS, future county administration, in any form, of the  
29 NIDA grant would have to include a substantial increase in  
30 federal support, resolution of the deficit issues associated with  
31 previous years' administration, community based control of the  
32 program, and central intake processes to insure accountability.  
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
