MOTION NO. 4096

A MOTION delaring the week of March 19 through March 26 to be Equal Rights Week in King County.

WHEREAS, King County is committed to the goals of insuring to all persons their full rights and liberties, free of all forms of prejudice, and

WHEREAS, the citizens of the State of Washington in 1972 voted to amend the State Constitution to prohibit discrimination on the basis of sex, and

WHEREAS, the Washington State Legislature on March 22, 1973 ratified the Equal Rights Amendment to the U. S. Constitution, and

WHEREAS, the Month of March 22 through April 22 is being observed by a number of King County area organizations as Equal Rights Month.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Week of March 19 through March 26, 1979 is proclaimed as Equal Rights Week in King County. All citizens of King County are urged to join in the spirit of freedom upon which this nation is based and to help make equality a reality for all.
