A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$9,970 to support Clise Mansion restoration research and design project, Grant File No. 912:2.

WHEREAS, the National Endowment for the Arts is empowered to make grants to support research and design of cultural facilities, and

WHEREAS, the Clise mansion restoration will assist the County in meeting the needs of the public, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$9,970 as a cash match in support of the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$9,970 to the National Endowment for the Arts for the Clise Mansion restoration research and design, on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

4. The National Endowment for the Arts is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
