MOTION NO. 4161

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to enter into a contract with the City of Redmond for a franchise, for a sewer pipeline along Avondale Road Beginning and ending at the City limits of Redmond, to construct, maintain and operate said sewer pipeline.

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond, as provided in R.C.W. 36.55.010 of the State of Washington, has properly filed an application for a franchise to construct, maintain and operate a sewer pipeline, and

WHEREAS, the Boundary Review Board and the Utilities Technical Review Committee have approved the location of this pipeline and it is deemed to be in compliance with comprehensive plans, since no hook-ups will be made within the unincorporated area of King County.

WHEREAS, the application has been referred to the County Executive for investigation of the feasibility thereof and the checking of plans and description of the location thereof; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended approval of the franchise.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into and execute the attached sewer system franchise contract for the City of Redmond, which by this reference is incorporated herein as part of the Motion, said franchise is granted to the City of Redmond for the term of 15 years.

If within thirty (30 days) after the granting of this franchise the applicant shall have failed to sign the incorporated written acceptance herein, then the herein granted rights and privileges shall be forfeited and said franchise shall be declared null and void.
