

MOTION NO. 4232

A MOTION denying the petition by Gerald Harkelroad and Others for the vacation of a portion of South 102nd Street, concurring with the recommendation of the Department of Public Works (V-1526)

WHEREAS, Gerald Harkelroad and others have submitted a petition for the vacation of a portion of South 102nd Street; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works investigated the proposed petition and the vacation area and recommends that the petition be denied; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Building and Land Development reviewed the subject road vacation and advises that this roadway should remain in the public street system to improve neighborhood circulation. Current neighborhood access is limited due to poor sight distance and substandard right of ways; and

WHEREAS, the Operations Division of the Department of Public Works recommends denial as the area will be required for future road system development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council concurs with the recommendations of the Department of Public Works and the Division of Building and Land Development and hereby denies the petition by Gerald Harkelroad and others for the vacation of a portion of South 102nd Street (V-1626)
