Burien, White Center and Seattle.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A 100,000 service hour minimum net increase be recommended
to provide local service between and within suburban cities and
communities "functioning as both feeder service to the express
system and for local service" in 1980. The cost to provide this
service should be absorbed from Metro's 1980 revenues and fund
balances.
