

MOOTION NO. 4395

A MOOTION denying the petition by Dennis J. Rieger and Others for the vacation of a portion of Novelty Hill Road, concurring with the recommendation of the Department of Public Works and the Real Property Division (V-1500)

WHEREAS, Dennis J. Rieger and Others have submitted a petition for the vacation of a portion of Novelty Hill Road; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works investigated the petition and records disclosed the proposed vacation area had been paved and maintained by the County during the period of 50 years since its establishment as a County road; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works recommended approval of the vacation petition in accordance with the provisions of King County Ordinance No. 00129, passed pursuant to R.C.W. 36.87 as amended by Charter 185, Laws of 1959, Extraordinary Session; and

WHEREAS, on June 9, 1976, the Real Property Division advised the petitioners of the assessed value of the adjoining land and requested compensation be paid to King County within ninety days pursuant to said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, over three years have passed without financial considerations having been satisfied, therefore, the Department of Public Works and the Real Property Division recommend that the petition for vacation be denied.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Council concurs with the recommendations of the Department of Public Works and the Real Property Division and hereby denies the petition of Dennis J. Rieger and Others for the vacation of a portion of Novelty Hill Road (V-1500).
