2 A MOTION concurring with the King County Executive's
3 allocation of \$25,000 of the historic preservation
4 block grant funds for the Neely Mansion Restoration
5 Project. The historic preservation block grant
6 funds were previously appropriated under the 1979
7 Housing & Community Development Block Grant Program.

8 WHEREAS, the King County Council has, through Ordinance 2991,
9 adopted the goal of preserving and selectively encouraging the
10 restoration of buildings, sites and areas that depict the
11 evolution of King County, and

12 WHEREAS, the King County Council has, through Ordinance 4112,
13 authorized the expenditure of \$59,000 in 1979 Housing & Community
14 Block Grant Funds for historic preservation projects, and

15 WHEREAS, a committee of citizens representing the disciplines
16 of History, Architectural History, Musology and Historic
17 Preservation, appointed by the King County Executive, has
18 reviewed project proposals based on published criteria and has
19 identified the Neely Mansion Restoration project as one of
20 highest priority for County grant assistance, and

21 WHEREAS, the Association of King County Historical Organiza-
22 tions has, by motion, recommended that \$25,000 of the historic
23 preservation block grant funds be allocated for the Neely
24 Mansion Restoration Project, and

25 WHEREAS, the County Executive has reviewed and concurs with
26 the above recommendations;

27 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

28 The King County Council endorses the County Executive's
29 \$25,000 allocation of historic preservation grant funds for the
