

MOTION NO. 4653

2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
3 make a grant application for funds in the
4 amount of \$66,727 to the State of Washington
5 Traffic Safety Commission for an Alcohol
6 Information School Screening Project.

7 WHEREAS, persons driving while intoxicated present a serious
8 danger to all citizens of Washington State, and

9 WHEREAS, such persons, when convicted, are referred by the
10 Courts to Alcohol Information School, and

11 WHEREAS, no standardized mechanism is uniformly used in
12 diagnosing the alcohol problems of Alcohol Information School
13 clients, and

14 WHEREAS, a standardized diagnostic tool, the New Jersey
15 Countermeasures Screening Instrument, is available and can be
16 utilized to identify alcoholic clients in a cost-effective manner,
17 and

18 WHEREAS, the State Bureau of Alcohol and Substance Abuse has
19 encouraged the utilization of this diagnostic tool and is
20 supportive of a pilot project utilizing it in King County, and

21 WHEREAS, the State Department of Licensing views the
22 information generated by this project as directly benefitting the
23 clients served and all citizens of the State of Washington.

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to
26 execute and submit an application on behalf of King County,
27 Washington, to the State of Washington Traffic Safety Commission
28 in the amount of \$66,727 to fund an Alcohol information School
29 Screening Project for the period January 1, 1980, to December 31,
30 1981.

31 2. It is the Council's intent that the three positions
32 authorized in the grant application be funded only so long as the
33 State of Washington provides special funds to support them.

3. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file
and execute such application and contracts as required by the

1 State of Washington Traffic Safety Commission.


2 4. The Division of Alcoholism Services, a division of the
