MOTION NO. 4706

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the amount of \$47,835 to support the King County Law and Justice Planning function, Grant File No. 003.

WHEREAS, the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1973, as amended, and the proposed Law Enforcement Assistance Reform Act of 1979 provide for the award of grants by the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, U.S. Department of Justice, through the Washington Division of Criminal Justice, and

WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the need to support King County Law and Justice Planning Activities, and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds that provision of such services is in the public interest, and

WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide an amount of \$11,188 as a cash match in support of the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the amount of \$47,835, including \$2,093 as the State buy-in portion, to the State Division of Criminal Justice on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to file and execute such sub-contracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

4. The U.S. Department of Justice and the State of Washington are hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
