2 A MOTION to set the date for a hearing upon
3 the Maintenance Assessment Roll for Road
4 Improvement District No. 85 for Street Lights
5 in Kent Ridge Estates No. 3.

6 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 4496 created King County
7 Road Improvement District No. 85 for street lights in Kent Ridge
8 Estates No. 3. The installation has been completed and the
9 cost is now known; and

10 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 4496 directed the Director
11 of the Department of Public Works and Transportation, upon com-
12 pletion of the installation of the street lights, to prepare and
13 file with the King County Council Clerk, a Maintenance Assessment
14 Roll for the maintenance assessment to be levied against the
15 property included in Road Improvement District No. 85: The
16 Maintenance Assessment Roll has been prepared and filed with the
17 Clerk of the King County Council.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

19 Section 1: Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.090,
20 the hearing upon the Maintenance Assessment Roll for King County
21 Road Improvement District No. 85 shall be scheduled for

22 March 10, 1980, at 9:30 a.m.


23 Section 2: The King County Council will sit as a board of
24 equalization for the purpose of considering aforesaid assessment
25 roll at aforesaid hearing or hearings and will consider such
26 objections as are made thereto or any part thereof, and will
27 correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify said rolls or any
28 part thereof, or set aside said roll in order that such assessment
29 be made de novo, as to such body shall appear just and equitable,
30 and then proceed to confirm the same by ordinance.

31 Section 3: The Clerk of the King County Council is hereby
32 directed to give notice of hearing upon said roll to all owners
33 or reputed owners of the property whose name appears thereon by
mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen (15) days before the

1 date fixed for the hearing to such owners or reputed owners at
 2 the address of such as shown on the tax rolls of the County
 3 Comptroller; in addition thereto, such notices shall be published
 4 at least two (2) times in a newspaper of general circulation in
 5 the County. Such notices shall specify the time and place of
 6 hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons who may desire
 7 to object thereto to make such objections in writing and to file
 8 same with the Clerk of the Council at or prior to the date fixed
 9 for said hearing.
