2 A MOTION setting the date of hearing on the
3 Assessment Roll for King County Road Improve-
ment District No. 75

4 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 3242 passed by the King
5 County Council on June 6, 1977, established King County Road
6 Improvement District No. 75 (hereinafter "RID 75"); and

7 WHEREAS, the construction of the improvement project for
8 which the District was created has now been completed and the
9 total costs and expenses of the project can be predicted with
10 reasonable accuracy; and

11 WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and
12 Transportation has determined the total to be assessed against
13 all parcels therein to be \$359,814.81; and

14 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 3242 directed the Director
15 of the Department of Public Works and Transportation, upon
16 determination of the costs of the project to prepare and file with
17 the Clerk of the Council an assessment roll setting forth that
18 portion of the total costs and expenses of accomplishing the said
19 project which are to be assessed against the property within
20 RID 75 and the amount to be assessed against each parcel therein;
21 and

22 WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and
23 Transportation has prepared and filed said assessment roll;

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 Section 1: The Council hereby states its intention to hold
26 a public hearing pursuant to RCW 36.88.090, for the purpose of
27 considering the RID 75 assessment roll which is on file with the
28 Clerk of the Council. Said hearing is hereby scheduled for
29 May 19, 1980, 1980, at 9:30 a.m.

30 Section 2: At said hearing, the Council will sit as a board
31 of equalization for the purpose of considering said assessment
32 roll and will consider such written objections as are made
33 thereto or any part thereof, and will correct, revise, raise,

1 lower, change, or modify said roll or any part thereof. Or, the
2 Council may set aside said roll and make the assessments de novo
3 so that they are just and equitable and then proceed to confirm
4 the same by ordinance.

5 Section 3: The Clerk of the Council is hereby directed to
6 give notice of said hearing by mailing and by publication at the
7 times and in the manner set forth in RCW 36.88.090.
