MOTION NO. 4815

2 A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to
3 make a grant application for funds in the
4 approximate amount of \$716,000 to support
5 Bikeway Trail Projects, Grant File No. 012:2.

6 WHEREAS, the King County Council adopted the Urban Trails Plan
7 in 1971 (Motion No. 625 on 9/27/71), which proposed that two-thirds
8 of the trails should be constructed for walking or biking, about
9 one-fifth for bicycles and the remaining one-seventh for other
10 uses such as horseback riding; and

11 WHEREAS, the King County Council in 1976 adopted the King
12 County General Bicycle Plan (Motion No. 2314, 2/17/76); and

13 WHEREAS, the Federal Bikeway Demonstration Program of 1975
14 (P.L. 93-643, Section 119, passed 1/4/75) provided six million
15 dollars (\$6,000,000) nationwide of which King County received
16 \$320,000 for construction of the Interurban Trail; and

17 WHEREAS, King County, in conjunction with Puget Sound Power
18 and Light, Algona, Auburn, Kent, Pacific, Renton, and Tukwila were
19 able to complete only 6.25 miles out of a total 16 miles of the
20 Interurban Trail; and

21 WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation, Federal Highway
22 Administration administers a Bicycle Grant Program authorized by
23 Section 141(c) of the Surface Transportation Assistance Act of
24 1978; and

25 WHEREAS, four million dollars (\$4,000,000) nationwide has been
26 appropriated to carry out Section 141(c) during fiscal year ending
27 September 30, 1980 for State and Local bikeway-related projects;
28 and

29 WHEREAS, King County has numerous nonmotorized bikeway and
30 trail projects that have not been funded.

31 WHEREAS, the Council recognizes an obligation to provide the
32 amount of \$239,000 as a 25% cash match in support of the projects.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

2 1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make
3 application for funds in the approximate amount of \$716,000 to
4 the Department of Transportation, Federal Highway Administration
5 for the Bikeway Trail Projects on behalf of King County;


6 2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file
7 and execute such application and enter into and execute such
8 contracts as are required by the grantor;

9 3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter
10 into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the
11 implementation of the project;

12 4. The U.S. Department of Transportation is hereby assured
13 full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
