A MOTION authorizing the Director of the Department of Public Works to secure bids for the purchase of synthetic motor oils and oil additives for use on a limited trial basis in selected County vehicles.

WHEREAS, Executive Directive D-134 establishes an energy conservation program for County vehicles, and

WHEREAS, the operation of County vehicles is a major component of County energy consumption and represents a major expense to the taxpayers of the County, and

WHEREAS, synthetic oil products claim to offer improved mileage and lower maintenance costs, and .

WHEREAS, these synthetic oil products are made in the United States and constitute a potential method of reducing the County's dependence on foreign oil and at the same time capitalize on energy savings, and

WHEREAS, all products to be tested shall not affect vehicle warranties, shall meet the Society of Automotive Engineers' standards for motor oils, and shall meet one of the following: U.S. Environmental Protection Agency emission standards or the California Air Quality standard,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County: The Director of the Department of Public Works is hereby authorized to direct the Fleet Administrator to secure bids for the purchase of synthetic oil for use on a limited trial basis in order to determine what, if any, benefits the County may incur with the use of synthetic oils.
