A MOTION remanding the application for reclassification petitioned by James H. Diamond, and designated Building and Land Development File No. 301-79-R, to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner.

WHEREAS, the Deputy Zoning and Subdivision Examiner has recommended denial of this application because it is in conflict with Ordinance 4268,

WHEREAS, the applicant has raised at appeal significant issues concerning the possibility that the County may have misled him into believing his prior Planned Unit Development approval to still be in effect,

WHEREAS, the County Council believes the Examiner should consider evidence and arguments concerning the possibility the applicant was misled by his dealings with the County;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The application of James H. Diamond be remanded to the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner for the purpose of hearing further evidence and arguments from the parties in regard to the applicant's dealings with the County subsequent to September 15, 1977.
