

MOTION NO. 4915

1 A MOTION commending the Committee to Save School Trust
2 Lands, State, Municipal, School District officials and
private citizens for their efforts in successfully accom-
plishing the transfer of State Lands to Big Finn Hill Park.

3 WHEREAS, approximately eighty (80) acres of State School Trust Land, valued
4 at nearly one million dollars have been transferred to King County as an ad-
5 dition to Big Finn Hill Park, and

6 WHEREAS, King County Parks and Recreation plans to develop the newly
7 acquired acreage into playfields, picnic areas, and trails, and

8 WHEREAS, nearly ninety thousand dollars has been already allocated for
9 Phase One development of the active playfield area, including design, and

10 WHEREAS, with a total of one hundred forty acres, the Big Finn Hill
11 Park has become one of the largest parks in the King County Parks System, and

12 WHEREAS, the transfer of State lands will connect Big Finn Hill Park with
13 St Edward's State Park to the north under anticipated plans, and

14 WHEREAS, the King County Council recognizes and appreciates the efforts of
15 the Committee to Save School Trust Lands, composed of Penny Frey, Rebecca Hirt,
16 Jackie Kapanjie, Dr. R. C. Kapanjie, Ted McCagg, Donna McGraw, Robert Overly,
17 Muriel Romer, Billie Vlases, and

18 WHEREAS, the Council recognizes the many contributions of State, Municipal,
19 and School District officials, and private citizens, without whose cooperative
20 efforts this accomplishment would not have been possible, and

21 WHEREAS, the contributions of these individuals, government agencies and
22 the Committee to Save School Trust Lands will result in a lasting improvement
23 of the quality of life for the citizens of King County,

24 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 The Committee to Save School Trust Lands, State, Municipal, School District
26 officials and private citizens who worked for the successful transfer of State
27 Lands to Big Finn Hill Park are hereby commended and thanked for their efforts.
