MOTION NO. 4988

A MOTION declaring the intention of the King County Council to create Road Improvement District No. 90 for street lights in the plat of Covington Firs and to set a date and place for a public hearing.

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the King County
Council requesting the formation of a Road Improvement District
for the erection of ornamental street lights in the streets in the
plat of Covington Firs. The petition requests that the payment
for the improvement be made by special assessment payable in whole
at the conclusion of the project and the King County Council's
acceptance of the final assessment roll.

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the King County Council on April 29, 1980, referred the above said petition to the Director, Department of Public Works and Transportation for his checking and recommendation, and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has determined that said petition has been signed by owners of an aggregate amount of the majority of the lineal frontage upon the improvement to be made, and of an aggregate amount of the majority of the area within the limits of the assessment district to be created therefor, and that the improvement appears to be feasible, and that the benefits appear to exceed the cost of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby found that said petition is sufficient and that the proposed District is sufficiently developed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. It is the intention of the Council to establish pursuant to the aforesaid petition and pursuant to Chapter 36.88 RCW, a road improvement district in King County to be known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 90" (hereinafter "RID 90). It is intended that RID 90 shall include all the territory described as follows:

All of the plat of Covington Firs as recorded in Volume 100 of Plats, pages 100 and 101, Records of King County, Washington, except Tracts A, B, C and D.

- B. It is further the intention of the Council to order the improvement of those portions of the following described streets within RID 90 by the erection of ornamental street lights:
- 1. Southeast 279th Place from 166th Avenue SE easterly to the east cul-de-sac.
- 2. 166th Avenue SE from Covington Way SE to SE 277th Street,
- 3. SE 278th Street from 166th Avenue SE westerly to the west cul-de-sac,
- 4. SE 277th Street from 166th Avenue SE to the east line of the plat of Covington Firs,
- 5. 168th Avenue SE from the north line of the plat of Covington Firs southerly to the south cul-de-sac.

Said lights are to be served from the existing undergound electrical facilities. Said improvements are hereafter sometimes referred to collectively as the "Project."

- C. The total cost and expense of the project which is to be borne by all of the property owners within RID 90 except Lot 3, is now estimated to be \$128.95 per lot. These costs are based on a King County Fee of \$35 per buildable lot and a Puget Sound Power & Light Company fee of \$626.34 per light. The final amount of said costs and expense to be borne by said property owners will be determined upon completion of the "Project", will be assessed against the benefited private property within the district, with such assessment levied on the basis of equal assessment for each platted building lot.
- D. It is further the intention of the Council that the assessments will be paid in full within 30 days of a date to be hereafter set by the Council.

- All persons who wish to object to or to otherwise be heard on the creation of proposed Road Improvement District No. 90 described herein, on the accomplishment of the Project described herein, or on the assessment of their property for the costs and expenses of accomplishing the Project in the manner described herein, are hereby notified to appear and present their objections or testimony at an open public meeting of the King County Council to be held in Room 402 of the King County Courthouse, Seattle, Washington, at 9:30 a.m. on the 29th day of september, 1980. At such time and place, the Council intends to hear such objections and testimony and to act on the intention set forth herein.
- The clerk of the Council is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of said public hearing by publication and by mailing at the times and in the manner described in RCW 36.88.050.
- The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation is hereby directed to submit to the Council at, or prior to, the date fixed for said hearing, a diagram or print showing thereon the lots, tracts, and parcels of land and other property which will be specially benefited thereby, and the estimated amount of the cost and expense of said improvement to be borne by each lot, tract, or parcel of land or other property, and also designating thereon all property which is being purchased under contract from the County.
- "Costs and expenses of accomplishing the Project" as used herein, shall mean those costs and expenses described in RCW 36.88.30
