WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, provides for the award of grants to jurisdictions participating in an areawide Housing Opportunity Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Puget Sound Regional Housing Opportunity Plan has been awarded \$727,000 in Community Development Block Grant funds to be used by participating jurisdictions and agencies to carry out activities in support of the Regional Housing Opportunity Plan, and

WHEREAS, \$100,000 of the above Community Development Block Grant funds have been set aside for projects involving two or more jurisdictions to promote mobility opportunities for persons living in areas of concentration to housing in areas of non-concentration, and

WHEREAS, in addition, the county has developed a successful Airport Homes Relocation Project, which it wishes to expand in furtherance of the Housing Opportunity Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds to the Puget Sound Council of Governments for the following projects:

- A. Airport Homes Relocation Project \$149,853
- B. Joint Seattle, King County, and Bellevue Rental Housing Opportunities Project \$40,000

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
