A MOTION recognizing the value of weatherization services and the availability of new funding to expand existing County weatherization program and authorizing the County Executive to apply to and contract with the City of Seattle to provide weatherization services to County residents.

WHEREAS, King County operates a Unified Weatherization Program for low income homeowners in all parts of the county excluding Seattle, and

WHEREAS, certain residents of unincorporated King County also reside within the Seattle City Light service area, and

WHEREAS, Seattle City Light has funds available to provide weatherization services for customers in electrically heated homes, and

WHEREAS, Seattle Light will make weatherization services available to low income customers who live within the corporate limits of Seattle by contracting with the City of Seattle Department of Human Resources, and

WHEREAS, King County Division of Housing and Community Development currently operates weatherization services from several funding sources and could provide services to Seattle City Light customers residing in the unincorporated areas through expansion of the existing Unified Weatherization Program.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County Council recognizes the value of providing weatherization services to County residents.

B. The County Executive is hereby authorized to apply to and contract with the City of Seattle for funds available through City Light for the provision of weatherization services to eligible County residents.
