

MOTION NO. 5061

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$387,526 to support Alcoholism Treatment Services.

WHEREAS, the Alcohol, Drug Abuse, and Mental Health Administration is empowered to make grants to support Alcoholism Treatment Services, and

WHEREAS, the Alcoholism Treatment Services Grants will assist the County in meeting the needs of persons who are disabled or of Asian origins, and

WHEREAS, the Council of King County finds that provision of such services is in the public interest.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

1. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application to the Alcohol, Drug Abuse and Mental Health Administration for funds in the approximate amount of \$171,210 for an Asian Alcoholism Outreach and Education program and in the amount of \$216,316 for an Alcoholism Outreach program for Physically Disabled Persons on behalf of King County;

2. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

3. The King County Executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
