

MOTION NO. 5071

A MOTION endorsing Referendum 38 and Referendum 39 for passage in November, 1980

WHEREAS, a safe and adequate water supply is essential to public health, and

WHEREAS, the long range development goals for the state of Washington require an adequate supply of water for domestic, industrial, agricultural, municipal, fishery, recreational and other beneficial uses, and

WHEREAS, the cost of needed water supply facilities is beyond the resources of local government and individual users, and

WHEREAS, construction of waste disposal facilities is needed to protect the environment and to meet federal water quality requirements, and

WHEREAS, federal and state resources are not meeting the present need for \$1.6 billion in waste disposal construction funding and the cost is beyond the resources of local government and individual users.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council endorses Referendum 38 and Referendum 39 for passage in November, 1980.
