WHEREAS, the County Council, by Motion 5064 set a hearing date of December 9, 1980, and established a process for the designation of King County as a Countywide (exclusive of Seattle) Community Action Agency, and

A MOTION rescinding Motion 5064 and thereby

WHEREAS, a similar hearing has already been held before the Health and Human Services Committee on March 11, 1980, on designation of South King County Multi-Service Center as a Community Action Agency for Southern King County, and

WHEREAS, the North-East Multi Service Center has expressed interest in such a designation for Northern and Eastern King County, and

WHEREAS, recent events may lead to a reorganization of the Federal Community Services Administration and therefore to the Community Action Agency system, and

WHEREAS, the Multi-Service Centers have suggested by letter and the County agrees that any designation of a Community Action Agency for King County, exclusive of Seattle, would be premature at this time;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. Motion 5064 which scheduled a public hearing and established a process for designation of King County as a Community Action Agency is hereby rescinded.
- B. This action should not be construed as a refusal by the County Council to designate a Community Action Agency nor an abrogation of its authority to make such designation or designations in the future after due notice and public testimony.
